HOW TO HANDLE BATTERIES AT HOME:

1. TAPE SHINY SIDES OF THE BATTERY
(USE PACKING TAPE/CLEAR TAPE)
2. STORE NO LONGER THAN ONE YEAR
3. BRING TO PARTICIPATING BATTERY RECYCLING PROGRAM
4. IF DAMAGED/SWOLLEN BATTERY, CONTACT LCRMS
