



EVERGREEN SEEDLINGS

White Spruce

Grows between 40-60'. Needles 1/2 to 1 inch long, and are bluegreen in color with aromatic foliage. Likes cool, moist, well drained soil. Sun exposure ranging from partial sun/shade to full sun. This popular garden conifer is native to Canada and the northern United States.

3 year seedlings 8-16" 10 seedlings/\$15.00



Canaan Fir

Grows between 40-60' with a 10-20' spread. Slightly soft, dark green needles that are 1" long. Traditional evergreen native to the Blue Ridge Mountains. Grows well in a variety of soils and is beautiful as a single planting or windbreak.

DECIDUOUS SEEDLINGS

Chinese Chestnut

Grows between 40-60' in height with a spread of 40-60' As the American chestnut struggles with disease, the blight-resistant Chinese chestnut is quickly gaining popularity. The sweet-tasting nuts are often roasted for holiday eating. Grows in full sun, and well drained soils.

DECIDUOUS SEEDLINGS



Shagbark Hickory

Grows between 60-80' with a 30-50' spread. A native tree named for its shaggy, peeling bark. As a member of the walnut family, shagbark hickory produces edible nuts. Sun exposure ranging from full sun to partial sun/shade. Prefers moist, well-drained soils.

4 year seedlings 12-24" 10 seedlings/\$15.00

Chestnut Oak

Grows between 60-70' with a 60-70' spread. Fall color varies from red to orange to yellow-brown. Sun exposure ranging from full sun to partial sun/shade. Prefers acidic, moist, well-drained soil.

3 year seedlings 15-30" 10 seedlings/\$15.00





Silver Maple

Grows between 50-70' with a 30-50' spread. Silver maple is a tall, fast growing, native tree of eastern North America. It is usually found growing in open sunlight along creeks. Sun exposure ranging from full sun to partial sun/shade. Prefers moist, well-drained or wet soils.

5 year seedlings 2-4' 10 seedlings/\$15.00

American Persimmon

Grows between 30-50' with a 20-30' spread. Fruiting begins after 4-9 years and require a male and female to bear fruit. Fruit ripens in late fall, ranging from yellow to orange. Grows best in full sun with well-drained, acidic soils.

DECIDUOUS SHRUBS

American ElderberryGrows between 5-12' with a 5-12'



spread. Small, fragrant, white flowers bloom in the spring that are followed by clusters of dark purple to black, berry like fruits in the late summer to fall. Fruits often used to make preserves, jellies, pies, and wine. Fruit is attractive to birds, butterflies, and other wildlife. The leaves are bright green and pinnately compound (5-11 leaflets each). Elderberry can tolerate erosion, clay, and wet soil, Best used when massed together and can be seen in roadside plantings, in wet or low areas, as a screen, or part of a native plant border. Full sun to part shade.
